Trainers involved in providing funded Work Based Learning (WBL) may also be required to obtain a teaching qualification in order to satisfy the funding requirements. Highfield Awarding Body of Compliance (HABC) qualifications are registered on the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF) with a credit value of 6, regardless of whether the course is completed at Level 3 or Level 4.

What are the entry requirements?

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification; however, there is a considerable amount of written work to be completed. This will involve reading of supplied reference books, researching specific topics, applying theory to practical scenarios and demonstrating knowledge and understanding through written work. Therefore, candidates for this course should have a good standard of written and verbal communication skills. Access and use of a computer which is preferable due to written assignments.

Course Information:

The course is organised over 5 days or 30 Guided Learning Hours (GLH) the learner is to complete 5 written assignments and 1 x 30 minute micro session in front of their peers on a subject of their choice, either work related or a subject that the learner would have a sound knowledge in.
